

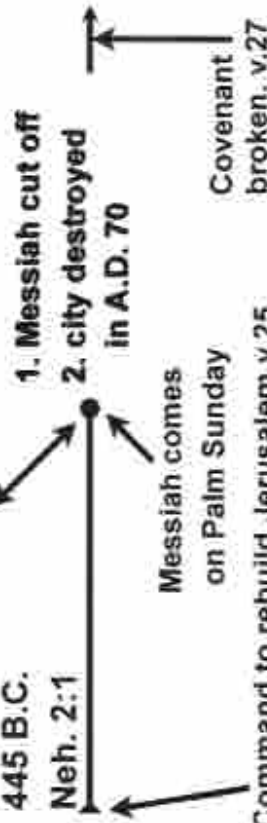
The 70 weeks of Daniel 9:24-27

70 sevens = 490 years

$$[7 \times 7 \underline{s} + 62 \times 7 \underline{s}] + [\text{gap}] + [1 \times 7] = *483 \text{ yrs.} + 7 \text{ yrs.}$$

*445BC - 483yrs = 38A.D. (Is there a problem here?)

Daniel 10 - Daniel's 4th vision introduced

- Time: 10:1 the 3rd year of Cyrus, king of Persia
- Preparation: 10:2-4 three weeks of self-denial
- The Christophany: 10:5-7 cp. Rev. 1:10-18
- Daniel, (one greatly loved, highly esteemed and precious in God's sight - 9:23, 10:11, 19) is strengthened 3 times in 10:8-19 to receive revelation from the "Scripture of Truth". v.21
- What will this unnamed angel do when he leaves Daniel and who will then come forth according to v. 20?
- No one stands to assist the unnamed angel except who? v.21 cp. v.13

When was Palm Sunday - the coming of Messiah the Prince into Jerusalem?

- What was the date of 1st. temple cleansing?
Ans.(Jn.2:13-20) approx. A.D.27
- Age of Christ when He began his (3 yr.?) ministry?
Ans.(Lk.3:23) approx. 30
- Christ's birth approx. 6-4 B.C.? Herod died 4 B.C.?
- How long are these 490 "years"?
Ans.Gen.7:11,24; 8:4 and Rev.11:2,3;12:6,14;13:5
A (Biblical, Prophetic)? year was **360** days long.
But a solar year is 365.2422 days therefore we "overshot" each of the 483 years by 5.25 days.
5.25 x 483 = 2535.75 days ÷ 360 = 7.04 yrs.
A.D.38 - 7yrs. = **Palm Sunday**, approx. **A.D.31 (- 1)**

B. 11:36-45 The last Gentile-Roman world ruler in power at the time of the second advent

2. There will be 3 more kings in Persia and then a 4th who through the use of riches will stir up all against Greece. v.2
